## Worlds' First Advanced Water Treatment System for Pools Delivers Cleaner, Healthier Water

Developed by Pure Vision Technologies, the innovative AquaGen Advanced Oxidation System dramatically increases the highly dissolved oxygen content of your pool. Higher residual oxygen levels in the water have proven to provide enhanced disinfecting and oxidizing capabilities. AquaGen decreases the amount of traditional chemicals used by up to 50 percent, including sanitizers such as chlorine and bromine, pH control chemicals and specialty chemicals.

The AquaGen system delivers 95+% pure oxygen that atomizes and injects the oxygen back into the pool recirculation loop. Increased oxygen levels offers many health benefits to the swimmer, as proven by many medical centers and hospitals that are using oxygenated water for healing burn patients. A single AquaGen system treats up to 200,000 gallons, helping to control algae since it is tougher for algae to grow in a highly oxygenated environment, and easily adapts to your existing or new filtration and chemical treatment system.
